

QUESTIONS FROM THE NCAA 2013 TEST

Answer True or False for each question

Cite the Rule

1. Umpires must communicate with each other any time there are two outs.
2. The ball four signal should be used when the count is three balls, the batter obviously tries to get hit and is hit by the next pitch.
3. When a batter does not obviously attempt to get hit by a pitched ball and the ball hits the batter in the batter's box, the batter shall be awarded first.
4. A substitute is charged to the Flex if she leaves the DP's batting position and returns to playing only defense.
5. With no outs, R1 is on first, R2 is on second, R1 leaves early as the batter-runner hits a ground ball to the third baseman who steps on third for the out. The defense may elect to have R1 called out and return R2 to second base and the batter to bat with the previous count.
6. The batter does not have to attempt to avoid being hit by a pitched ball that is entirely within the batter's box.
7. No run shall be scored if the third out of an inning is the result of a batter-runner being called out before reaching first base or any other runner forced out because of the batter becoming a batter-runner.
8. The strike zone is the area above home plate between the bottom of the batter's sternum and the top of her knees when she assumes her natural batting stance.
9. Upon arrival to the field, each coach shall provide a printed copy of the current NCAA Softball Approved Bat List available on the NCAA and SUP Arbiter Sports websites as amended through communication from the NCAA relating to bats added to or scratched from the list. The list provided for each game shall indicate, via highlighting, each model bat available for play.
